- We believe that the Textus Receptus Greek text (also called The Received Text) as translated in the King James Version is the perfect, complete, eternal _____ for the English-speaking world.
 - The _____ Text or the _____ Text?
 - The Critical Text is based mostly on two manuscripts – Vaticanus and Sinaiticus – yet those manuscripts disagree with each other over 3,000 times in the Gospels alone.
 - The KJV was translated with greater _____ than any other translation.
 - The KJV is an “_____” translation.
 - In the Scripture God places great emphasis on each individual word.
 - The phrases *word of God* and *words of God* is found fifty-five times in the Bible.
 - *Every word of God is pure. (Proverbs 30:5)*
 - *Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God. (Luke 4:4)*
 - *The word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword. (Hebrews 4:12)*
 - *The worlds were framed by the word of God. (Hebrews 11:3)*
 - Scripture only references the thoughts of God three times.
 - God does not think like us.
 - Isaiah 55:8-9 “For my thoughts *are* not your thoughts, neither *are* your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.”
 - It is the height of arrogance and foolishness to think any person can – with complete accuracy – convey the sense of the thoughts of God.
 - Most other translations are thought-for-thought instead of word-for-word.
 - Dynamic Equivalence instead of Formal Equivalence
